

# Beach Kindy - Little Footprints

4 hour program at NBEEC



Children will have the opportunity to **connect with and contribute to their world** through meaningful experiences in natural environments and authentic engagement with Country, culture and community.

During the day children will **show respect for diversity** by learning with and from Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultural knowledge holders and **show respect for the environment** by exploring interactions between people and the natural environment through hands-on outdoor learning experiences.

Children will become nature scientists, **confident and involved learners**, as they connect with a range of outdoor learning spaces throughout the day. These natural environments invite open-ended interactions, exploration, discovery, creativity and connection with nature through play-based and inquiry-driven learning experiences.

Children will develop a **strong sense of wellbeing** through movement, sensory exploration, outdoor play and opportunities to build confidence, resilience and independence in natural environments.

Children will develop as **effective communicators** as they expand language through listening, responding, storytelling, questioning and shared experiences. The Turrbal language will be integrated throughout the day through greetings, group animal names, symbols and counting patterns.
