Beach Kindy - Little Footprints 4 hour program at NBEEC Kindy students will have the opportunity to *connect* and contribute to their world. They will show respect for diversity by learning about Aboriginal culture and **respect for the environment** by exploring interactions between people and the environment. This program enhances the capacity of senior students through a 'Kids teaching kids' concept enabling the opportunity to *develop intercultural connections* through sharing cultural knowledge across generations. Students will become nature scientists. confident and active in their learning, as they connect with many outdoor learning spaces during the day. These natural spaces will invite open-ended interactions, exploration, discovery and connection with nature. Students will develop as *effective communicators* as they explore and expand language through listening and responding.
