

Beach Explorers Using Senses - Prep

Full Day program at NBEEC



Prep Nature Scientists will **use their five senses** to explore and interact with animals and plants living at Nudgee Beach discovering at this **special place** that "Little Things do Matter".



Parent helpers will support students as they sieve for green paddle worms and amphipods, use yabby pumps to draw up yabbies and crabs and mould marine creatures in the sand. Students will learn about the features of special Mangrove trees and how they provide a valuable habitat and support for animals living in the Intertidal zone on a guided walk with a NBEEC staff member.



During the day **they suggest how the environment affects them and other living things.**

At the Centre, students will get to see a live mud crab and then pretend to be one as they walk through trays into a burrow. Playing the high tide/low tide game with puppets is always a highlight along with handling live hermit crabs, sea cucumbers and sea stars.



At the end of the day **they reflect on their learning to suggest ways they can care for a familiar place.**
