Element 1 - This first Element is for the students to really get a feel of where their learning is heading. Allow the students to just watch this video. However, I do challenge your family to plant something and watch it grow. You could even find out what Australian plants attract butterflies and plant those.

Element 2, 3 and 4 - These Elements are all to be used in combination with each other. The best idea would be if the student could watch the video (E2). Then complete the worksheet (E3). However, the information in E4 is really specific for the butterfly and may be beneficial for you and your student to read together before you complete the worksheet (E3). It would be great if E3 could be printed.

Element 5 - Students are now moving their learning from the Bush to the Beach. This element is an introduction to the beach life stages. Allow your student to enjoy watching this element.

Element 6, 7 and 8 - These Elements are to be used together. E8 needs to be printed and would be helpful to have as you watch the videos. As you watch the videos you will need to press pause when the student needs to tally/count the animals.

REMEMBER IF YOU CAN'T PRINT JUST WRITE YOUR ANSWERS IN A NOTE PAD AND STORE WITH YOUR SCIENCE WORK.
