Nudgee Beach Environmental Education Centre

Nudgee Beach Environmental Education Centre (NBEEC) is 19 km from the centre of Brisbane City, adjacent to the Bramble Bay section of the Moreton Bay Marine Park, the Boondall Wetlands Reserve and the Kedron Brook Floodway.

Your students will learn about varied topics relevant to your curriculum, mainly focused on wetlands and marine environments and their catchments. NBEEC's high-quality education programs will give your students real learning experiences in exciting and dynamic ways.

These programs encourage your students to be environmentally and culturally aware of our past, present and future environmental footprints, as the future keepers of our global wetlands.

Nudgee Beach Full-Day Program

Provide your international visitors with a unique Australian experience learning about marine animals.

Teachers at the Centre will show your students a link between their country and Nudgee Beach using the migratory wader birds (Eastern Curlew).



Students explore the foreshore to discover the small, often unseen animals that the curlews rely on for food. The day finishes at Anne Beasley's lookout where your students see the different ways Moreton Bay can be used while still protecting the environment.

Bush to Beach Full-Day Program

This program may begin at the beach or bush depending on the tides.

Learn about forest ecology, see colourful lorikeets and other wildlife and learn how to recognise the tracks of echidnas, wallabies and possums. Make damper bread on an open fire.



Investigate the Nudgee Beach mangrove ecosystem including birds, crabs and molluscs. Lunch is provided.
